DIRECTIVE NO. 2010 - 101

MILK TRANSPORTATION RATES FOR PRODUCERS

Pursuant to Section 24 (7) of the *Alberta Milk Marketing Regulation (151/2002)*, Alberta Milk sets the transportation rates and routes.

Definitions

- 1 The definitions in the *Alberta Milk Marketing Regulation* apply to the interpretation of this directive.

Rates

- 2 Alberta Milk sets the following rates:
 - (a) That the producer hauling rate be set at \$2.38 per hl plus a \$19.54 yard charge per pickup.
 - (b) That any surplus or deficit as a result of primary hauling will be adjusted, monthly, through the secondary pool.

Exemption

- 3 This directive does not apply to goat and sheep milk.

Effective Date

- 4 This Directive replaces Milk Transportation Directive No. 2009-100.
- 5 This Directive comes into effect on August 1, 2010.
