**DIRECTIVE NO. 2007 - 100**

**MILK TRANSPORTATION RATES FOR PRODUCERS**

Pursuant to Section 24 (7) of the *Alberta Milk Marketing Regulation (151/2002)*, Alberta Milk sets the transportation rates and routes.

**Definitions**

- 1 The definitions in the *Alberta Milk Marketing Regulation* apply to the interpretation of this directive.

**Rates**

- 2 Alberta Milk sets the following rates:
  - (a) That the producer hauling rate be set at \$2.09 per hl plus a \$17.53 yard charge per pickup.
  - (b) That any surplus or deficit as a result of primary hauling will be adjusted, monthly, through the secondary pool, upon approval of the Executive Committee.

**Exemption**

- 3 This directive does not apply to goat and sheep milk.

**Effective Date**

- 4 This Directive replaces Milk Transportation Directive No. 2006-100.
- 5 This Directive comes into effect on August 1, 2007.
